Request for water cut off can ONLY be made by the UNIT OWNER:

NO EXCEPTION

Non-EMERGIES, Planned Water SHUT OFF Days are ONLY: Tuesday and Friday Times: 9:00 am -1:00 pm

Please schedule NON-EMERGENCY WATER CUT OFF.

WATER SHUT OFF request must be submitted to Quality 1 Property Manager in writing 72 hours prior to WATER SHUT OFF.

Please submit:

- 1. A certified licensed plumber must be hired by the unit owner.
- 2. Quality I must have a copy of their certificate of insurance and company information regarding, who will be doing the plumbing repairs within your unit,(if something goes wrong with the repairs,) the owner IS responsible for any damages and repairs to your unit, any common area or any other unit affected by this repair.
- 3. Management will check out references, licenses number and insurance information.
- 4. You must submit:

- 7. Water is will not be cut off in 30% Weather or Snow
- 8. Water is will not be not cut off in 90% Humidity/Temperature.
